Activity 4: Here's your piece for this week: If you don't have your instrument, remember to listen, and learn the tune and rhythms anyway to play in class later. First do some warmups:

Top Tips!

- Have a look through, singing and reading the note names with the backing track and try to find the minim at the end.
- This piece uses the open G, D & A strings.
- Be careful that you don't play in the rests - stop playing and freeze like a statue!
- Remember there isn't a two-bar rest on the repeat, but you have to retake or make a circle with your bow ready to start again with a down bow.
- When you are confident playing this piece pizzicato, why not come back and try playing it arco?
