


## Welcome to Suffolk County Music Service Remote Learning for WCET Classes.



## Top Tips!


- Have a look through, singing and reading the note names with the backing track and try to find the minim at the end.
- This piece uses the open G, D & A strings.
- Be careful that you don't play in the rests stop playing and freeze like a statue!
- Remember there isn't a two-bar rest on the repeat, but you have to retake or make a circle with your bow ready to start again with a down bow.
- When you are confident playing this piece pizzicato, why not come back and try playing it arco?
